

Year 4's 10 top tips to improve your times tables

1. Ask someone to ask you random times table questions.
2. Choose one tricky times table and ask someone to ask you random questions.
3. Write out one times table in order e.g. $1 \times 7 = 7$, $2 \times 7 = 14$
4. Choose one times table and write it out three times e.g. $3 \times 4 = 12$, $3 \times 4 = 12$, $3 \times 4 = 12$
5. Practise a times table torture test 12x12 grids. How long does it take?
6. Use a times table music disc to sing along to ([Amazon](#) or [WHSmiths](#)) or find free songs on YouTube. <http://www.youtube.com/watch?v=dzVyBQ5uTbo> or <http://www.youtube.com/watch?v=L-TNOhQxfDw> x3 Songs
7. Try worksheets, puzzles and games for times tables .e.g. [Times Tables Workbook 3: Workbook 3 - Age 7-11 \(Collins Easy Learning Age 7-11\)](#) from Amazon or WHSmiths but many other good books available
8. Try using an app to practise times tables.
9. Use My Maths Activities to practise your times tables. See Level 3-mixed x3, x4, x5 etc.
10. Try interactive games on www to find fun ways to practise times tables.
