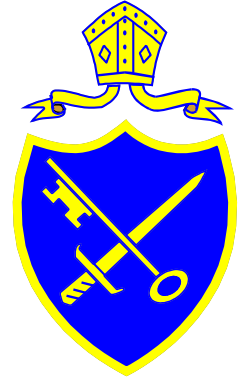


# BISHOP WOOD C OF E JUNIOR SCHOOL
