DRESS CODE



Staff at Bishop Wood C of E Junior School should dress in an appropriate way in order to ensure that a professional image is presented to pupils, parents and visitors.

Health and safety regulations should be adhered to.

Please bear in mind the following:

- Clothes should be both smart and practical
- Clothing should not cause embarrassment i.e. through over-exposure from low-cut tops, midriffs or underwear showing
- Skirts should be of a suitable length
- No denim (fabric, rather than colour) jeans, skirts, dresses or jackets
- No shorts or playsuits
- No combat trousers
- No strappy tops
- No body piercings or tattoos to be shown
- Footwear should be practical, appropriate and safe to wear
- Teachers must change into sports kit for PE sessions and trainers should be worn for these sessions only. Sports wear should also be presenting a smart but practical image
- PE kits should not be worn all day but teachers should change into kit and then change back for later sessions

All staff are expected to comply with the above guidelines. Where non-compliance is evident, line managers will need to determine the reasons for this with individual staff members and then report outcomes directly to the Headteacher.
