Re: Arrangements for September

From today, England has moved to Step 4 of the roadmap. Should this still be the case in September, school will be returning to 'normal' and the year group bubbles will no longer be in place. We will have a contingency plan in place should the national or local picture change and will share this with you as necessary.

Below are some key reminders ahead of September:

What do I need to know ahead of September?

Arrival and Departure

- The school day will run as normal with a 3.30pm finish.
- Pupils may enter the school from either the Frogmore Street or Christchurch Road Gate. Pupils should not be on site before 8.35am
- Pupils should go straight to their classroom and enter via the external fire door where a member of staff will greet them.
- For the first week or so, the Year 3 team will meet their pupils on the field near the Christchurch Rd gate.

The Classroom/School Day

- Year group 'Bubbles' will no longer be in use.
- There will be no social distancing necessary between the children in a bubble. Children will have break and lunch together. Lunches will be taken in the Dining Room.
- Tables in classrooms will be set out in a way which best supports learning.
- Verbal feedback within the lesson will be the main mechanism for marking/feedback.
- Each child must bring their own pencil case to school in September:
 - handwriting pens
 - HB pencils
 - small ruler
 - eraser
 - colouring pencils
 - sharpener
 - glue stick
 - scissors
- Children can take reading books to and from school.
- On PE days, children must wear their kit for the whole day. Your child will be advised which day they have PE in September.
- Daily whole school collective worship will return.

Cleaning and Protective Measures

It makes sense that some of the protective measures will remain in place. :

- Weather permitting, doors and windows will be kept open as much as possible.



- Hand washing will be encouraged throughout the school day. Children may bring in their own hand sanitiser but must not share it with other pupils.
- The whole school will be thoroughly cleaned at the end of each day.

Cases of Covid-19

- If your child has to isolate due to Covid-19, the class teacher will set work to complete at home. This will very likely be lessons from the Oak National Academy which dovetail into the learning taking place in school. It will be set via Google Classroom.
