An email was read out on behalf of Gary Stanley. Last year's fundraising paid for a new set of 30 laptops with their own charging box that the classes share. Each laptop is numbered and a child is assigned a number so they can pick up all their work from the point that they left it. This cuts down a lot of login time and has proved to work incredibly well. The charging box is on wheels and can be moved from class to class with ease.

The proposed spend for funds raised in 2023/24 are on the second phase of the woodland outdoor climbing area and to complete the pond area which was started in 2019. This would enrich outdoor learning. Also the visualisers that the teachers use daily are broken or in a bad state of repair and need replacing. These are a sought after tool for teachers and they can lay a piece of work on the visualiser, amend it and the amendment can be seen on the screen by all children.
