Re: Christmas Service in St Peter & St Paul Church – Monday 15th December 2025

Following the success of last year, we will once again be holding two Christmas Services in The Church of St Peter & St Paul. Year 5 lead the service and pupils from all year groups attend and punctuate at key moments.

The matinee will start promptly at 2pm. The evening performance will start at 7pm. The performances are expected to last approximately one hour.

The main reason for running two services is due to the constraints of space and numbers in the church. As such, we will be operating a ticket system for each of the performances. These will be limited to two tickets per family and can be booked via the School Gateway on a first come first served basis. There will be 150 places available at the matinee and 200 at the evening performance.

You can either book two tickets for the matinee, two for the evening, or one ticket for each performance. Any bookings which exceed this will be cancelled and you will only be allocated tickets if there are any available after all other valid requests have been fulfilled.

Tickets will be available to book via School Gateway on Friday 5th December – there will be two options available, matinee or evening. The system will close at 1pm on Wednesday 10th December. You will receive an email on Thursday 11th December to confirm that you have been allocated tickets, and physical tickets will be sent home via pupil post on Friday 12th December. You will need to bring these with you to the specific performance as only parents/carers with tickets will be admitted.

If you do not receive an email, then unfortunately you have not been allocated tickets.

Please note that the tickets are two per family, not per child.
