Year 4 Residential Trip to Woodrow High House - Wednesday 25th - Friday 27th June 2025

We are pleased to confirm that the Year 4 Residential Trip to Woodrow High House near Amersham will go ahead again this year, on the above dates. The objectives of the trip are to encourage independence, learn new skills and have some fun!

The total cost of the trip will be £278 per child to include food, tuition. The cost of travel to and from the site is being paid for by the school and is not included in this total, which is purely the cost for the stay at Woodrow.

To secure your child's place for the trip, a non-refundable deposit of £80 must be paid via the School Gateway by Friday 20th December 2024. The balance of £198 should be made via the School Gateway and can be paid in instalments. The date for receipt of the final payment is Thursday 27th March 2025.

It is our desire for as many of the children to attend the trip as possible. As such, please do not let the financial cost of the trip be a barrier to your child going. The school can and will support parents who may struggle to afford the trip. Please make contact via the office if you would like to discuss this further.

A short information meeting for parents will be held on **Wednesday 22**nd **January 2025 at 3.30pm in the school hall.** If this is not convenient, please contact the school office to arrange a different time to meet with the Year 4 teachers or have a chat over the phone.

Each class will need some parent volunteers to accompany us on the trip – please indicate in the comments section on the School Gateway if you would like to help. We will contact you nearer the time to confirm.

We have run this trip for several years and the majority of children have attended in the past. Feedback from children and parents has been extremely positive. However, if for any reason, your child will not be participating; alternative arrangements will be made for them in school for the three days.
