Ofsted

As you are all aware, we were notified on Monday that the school was being inspected by Ofsted. We welcomed two inspectors into school on Tuesday and Wednesday of this week, who took a thorough look at everything we do. Their findings will now be drafted into a report, checked for factual accuracy by all parties and put through a rigorous quality assurance process before the final report is published. In most cases, this process is completed within 35 working days of the inspection. Until then, however, school is unable to comment on the findings – which is always frustrating for all concerned!

However, I want to say that, across the two days, many of your children spoke with the inspectors, and they conducted themselves marvellously. We should all feel very proud of them for the way in which they engaged with the process. The children were engaged and lively, and their ideas and excitement about the school and the wider world fully embodied our Bishop Wood values.

It has been a busy and stressful week for all staff, and the messages of support sent in by many of you were invaluable in keeping us all going. We are now all looking forward to the long weekend, as I'm sure you are as well. I will, of course, be able to share more detail once the report has been finalised and published.
