Dear Parents and Carers,

We are excited to inform you that we have booked a Year 3 trip to RHS Wisley Gardens, on Wednesday 11th June. This trip is to support this term's learning in Science, where we are investigating how plants grow. During the day, the children will have the chance to explore the beautiful gardens and complete activities related to our learning about how plants grow.

This will be a practical and hands-on day. Children should wear their normal Bishop Wood tops with comfortable, sensible trousers or leggings. We suggest they wear trainers. They will need a waterproof coat if the weather looks wet and must wear sun cream and bring a sun hat as we'll be outside most of the day.

All children will need a packed lunch for this trip. Please can this lunch follow our expected guidance for normal packed lunches, ie, no fizzy drinks, sweets or food containing nuts. As it is a whole day trip, we would recommend an extra drink and a snack.

To allow time for traffic, we will need to leave school at 8.40 am. Please ensure your child is in school by 8.30am via the Frogmore St entrance. We plan to return to school by 3.30pm (traffic permitting!).

We would be grateful for a voluntary contribution of £21.50 per child, which will cover the cost of the trip including the coach and any admission fees. If you are able to, please make this contribution via the School Gateway by Friday 16th May. If the cost will prove beyond your family's means please contact Debs in the office, as we would not want the cost to be a barrier to your child taking part. If you would like to make an additional contribution that may help another family, you are able to do this using the 'Voluntary Contribution' payment section on the Gateway.

We will need a few parents to help on the day – please comment on the School Gateway if you would like to help. Please do not assume that volunteering to help means that you will be needed - we will contact parents nearer the time of the trip to confirm as we have a limited amount of space on the coach.
