## <u>Year 4 Trip – BAPS Shri Swaminarayan Mandir – Hindu Temple Neasden London</u>

We are excited to inform you that we have booked a Year 4 trip to the Hindu Temple in Neasden. This trip is to support this year's learning in RE about the Hindu religion and we will be attending the 'Understanding Hinduism' exhibition.

4PS will be visiting on Monday 18<sup>th</sup> November, and 4A on Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> November.

Children should wear their normal Bishop Wood Uniform, they will also need a coat.

All children will need a packed lunch for this trip. Please can this lunch follow our usual guidance for packed lunches, ie, no fizzy drinks, sweets or food containing nuts. As it is a whole day trip, we would recommend an extra drink and a snack for the morning.

The coach will be leaving Bishop Wood at 8.45am, therefore please could all pupils be in school ready for registration at 8.30am on the day of their trip. We will return to school by 3.30pm.

We would be grateful for a voluntary contribution of £15.70 per child, which will cover the cost of the trip including the coach, workshop and any admission fee. If you are able to, please make this contribution via the School Gateway by 11<sup>th</sup> November.

If the cost will prove beyond your family's means please contact Debs in the office as we would not want the cost to be a barrier to your child taking part.

If you would like to make an additional contribution that may help another family, you are able to do this using the 'Voluntary Contribution' payment section on the Gateway.

If your child is entitled to benefits-related Free School Meals then we will provide them with a packed lunch from our school kitchen. We will ask the children their preferred choice of sandwich filling from the following: cheese, ham or tuna. The lunch will also contain a piece of fruit or veg, a drink and a sweet treat! If you would like to send any additional items in then please feel free to do so, but this is not a requirement.
