Year 5 Trip to Lee Valley - Wednesday 19th June 2024

Year 5 will visit Lee Valley Regional Park on Wednesday 19th June 2024. We will leave after registration and expect to return to school by 3:30pm so children will be dismissed from their classrooms as usual. The day is a 'Mindfulness and Natural Art Discovery Day' where children will be introduced to mindfulness and wellbeing through outdoor experiences.

Children should wear school uniform for this trip and will need to bring a packed lunch and plenty of water. Please ensure lunch follows our guidance for packed lunches, ie, no fizzy drinks, sweets or food containing nuts.

If it looks like the weather will be hot, please apply sun cream before your child comes to school. A sunhat is advisable as is a waterproof, as the weather can change very quickly and we will be outside for most of the day.

We would be grateful for a voluntary contribution of £18.25 per child, which will cover the cost of the trip including the coach, workshops and any admission fees. If you are able to, please make this contribution via the School Gateway by Monday 20th May 2024.

If the cost will prove beyond your family's means please contact Debs in the office, as we would not want the cost to be a barrier to your child taking part.

If you would like to make an additional contribution that may help another family, you are able to do this using the 'Voluntary Contribution' payment section on the Gateway.

If your child is entitled to benefits-related Free School Meals then we are able to provide them with a packed lunch from our school kitchen. Please indicate in the comments section of the Gateway by Friday 14th June their preferred choice of sandwich filling from the following: cheese, ham or tuna.

If your child is entitled to benefits-related Free School Meals and you prefer to provide your child with your own packed lunch then please indicate 'lunch not required' in the comments section.

Please be reassured that all queries and comments are dealt with in the strictest confidence.

We will need some parents to help on the day – please comment on the School Gateway if you would like to help. Please do not assume that volunteering to help means that you will be needed - we will contact parents nearer the time of the trip to confirm.

If we hold emergency medications for your child e.g epipens or inhalers, we will take them on the trip for your child. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact us.
